

## ITA Academy wins 2nd prize at the Digital Leader Award 2019 in the category "Culture in Berlin, Germany

On June 27, 2019 the ITA Academy from Aachen, Germany, was awarded second prize in the Digital Leader Award 2019 in the category "Culture". The ITA Academy won the prize for its contribution "Digital Capability Center Aachen - Experience Digital Transformation Live". The award ceremony took place in front of around 300 decision-makers from the German business community in Berlin, Germany.
